The mission of J. T. Fisher Funeral Services is to aid all families through the natural process of death by providing life celebration experiences. The ultimate goal of this final care ministry is achieved by extending comfort and education to bereaved families as they witness the transition of their loved ones from earth to eternity.

The goods and services shown below are those we can provide to our customers. You may choose only the items you desire. However, any funeral arrangements you select will include a charge for our basic services and overhead. If legal or other requirements mean you must buy any items you did not specifically ask for, we will explain the reason in writing on the statement we provide describing the funeral goods and services. Certain funeral services may be provided off-premises by other funeral service providers.

I. Professional Services of Funeral Director and Staff — \$2,795.00

Our fee for the basic services of a licensed funeral director and staff includes, but is not limited to, conducting the arrangement conference, coordinating and planning the visitation and service, obtaining necessary permits and submitting obituary notices. Also included in this charge are our operational expenses relative to our facility, such as insurance, maintenance, utility, secretarial, administrative, equipment, inventory and OSHA supplies and hazardous waste disposal expenses. This fee for our basic services and overhead will be added to the total cost of the funeral arrangements you select. This fee is already included in our charges for direct cremation, immediate burials and forwarding or receiving remains.

II. Embalming

Embalming is not required by law. Embalming may be necessary, however, if you select certain funeral arrangements, such as a funeral with viewing. If you do not want embalming, you usually have the right to choose an arrangement that does not require you to pay for it, such as direct cremation or immediate burial.

A. Normal remains — \$1,295.00

III. Other Preparation of the Deceased

A. General preparation and restoration including dressing, casketing, washing and cosmetology — \$350.00

B. Washing/disinfecting when no embalming/identification of remains — \$195.00

Note: When embalming is not desired, the natural progression of decomposition causes the likelihood of unpleasant odors to be present. We therefore require that any services conducted with the unembalmed remains present and not in a gasket-sealed container be conducted within three days from the date of death.

C. Restorative Art Charges — \$150.00 per hour

D. Remains held in preparation room after three days — \$175.00 per day

IV. Funeral Home Facilities

A. Facilities, Equipment and Staff for Visitation and Viewing — Full Day (9 hours) \$600.00 / 1/3 Day (3 hours) \$395.00

Our services will include visitation setup, placement of encased remains, display of floral arrangements, use of the visitation room, supervision and attendants for the visitation.

B. Facilities, Equipment, and Staff for Funeral Service at Our Chapel — \$595.00

Our services include directing the funeral service, setup and use of facilities, chapel music and other equipment, parking lot use and assistance; receiving and placement of any floral pieces; supervision of and staff to assist during the funeral service.

C. Equipment and Staff for Funeral Service at Other Facility — \$495.00

Our services include directing the funeral service, setup at other facility, parking lot assistance, receiving and placement of any floral pieces; supervision of and staff to assist during the funeral service; supervision of funeral service at other facility, equipment and additional staff necessary to conduct funeral service at other facility. Organists/musicians are not included. (Services including committal that exceeds 3 hours will be charged \$150.00 per hour thereafter.)

D. Facilities and Staff for Memorial Service/Evening Visitation at Our Chapel — \$595.00 (2 hours), \$100.00 each additional hour

Our services include directing the memorial service/evening visitation; setup and use of facilities, chapel music and other equipment, parking lot assistance, supervision of and staff to assist during the memorial service.

E. Equipment and Staff for Memorial Service at Other Facility — \$395.00

Our services include directing the memorial service, setup at the other facility, parking lot assistance, supervision of and additional staff necessary to conduct memorial service at other facility. Organists/musicians are not included. Service vehicle is not included.

F. Equipment and Staff for Graveside or Committal Service — \$395.00

Our services include directing the graveside or committal service, setup at the cemetery, parking assistance, supervision of the service along with equipment and staff necessary to conduct the service. Service vehicle is not included.

G. Equipment and Staff for Saturday and Sunday Service — \$550.00

V. Automotive Equipment

(Add \$3.50 for each mile outside 25-mile local radius)

A. Funeral Coach — \$395.00

B. Family Car (4 hour limit, \$75.00 each additional hour) — \$425.00

C. Flower Vehicle — \$150.00

D. Lead Car — \$295.00

E. Service Vehicle for transfer of remains to funeral home — \$395.00

F. Service Vehicle for transfer of remains to or from airport — \$395.00

VI. Forwarding of Remains to Another Funeral Home

This charge includes our service car for transfer of the remains to the funeral home, professional services of licensed funeral director and other staff, use of our preparation room for embalming, preparation and sanitation. This charge also includes necessary authorizations and local transportation to the airport. This charge does not include visitation, rites or ceremonies prior to the forwarding of the remains.

- A. With minimum shipping container — \$5,160.00
- B. With casket selected from our funeral home — \$4,880.00, in addition to cost of the casket
- C. Air Shipment Tray for Casketed Remains — \$130.00
- D. Shipping Combination Tray for Embalmed Bodies — \$280.00

VII. Receiving of Remains from Another Funeral Home

This charge includes removal of remains, transportation of remains to cemetery and basic services of staff. This charge does not include visitation, rites or ceremonies. Outer burial containers (a complete list is provided at our funeral establishment) and any required cash advances are in addition to this charge.

- A. Receiving of remains from another funeral home — \$3,585.00

VIII. Funeral Merchandise

- A. Caskets — \$722.00 to \$33,078.00 *A complete price list will be provided at our funeral establishment.
- B. Outer Burial Containers — \$1,100.00 to \$1,795.00 *A complete price list will be provided at our funeral establishment.

(In most areas of the country, state or local law does not require you to buy a container to surround the casket in the grave. However, many cemeteries require that you have a container so that the grave will not sink in. Either a burial vault or a grave liner will satisfy these requirements.) A \$500.00 set up fee (tent, chairs, and grass) applies in addition to the outer burial container price.

X. Immediate Burial — \$3,585.00 to \$36,663.00

This charge for immediate burial includes the service vehicle for the transfer of the remains to the funeral home and cemetery, any necessary authorizations, and basic services of our staff. This charge does not include the use of facilities and staff for any visitation or ceremony, public or private, prior to burial.

A. Immediate burial with casket provided by purchaser — \$3,585.00

B. Immediate burial with alternative container from our funeral establishment — \$3,865.00

C. Immediate burial with casket selected from our funeral establishment — \$3,585.00 plus cost of casket

D. Immediate burial with highest priced casket (Marsellus Masterpiece, solid mahogany) — \$36,663.00

In addition to this charge would be the cost of the outer burial container (a complete list will be provided at our funeral establishment). If required, the cemetery charges and other cash advance items as desired or requested will be added.

XI. Direct Cremation — \$3,585.00 to \$36,663.00

This charge for direct cremation includes the service vehicle for the transfer of the remains to the funeral establishment and the crematory, basic services of our staff and crematory fee. This charge does not include a fee for embalming or facilities and staff for a full family or public viewing or private or public ceremony.

A. Direct cremation with container provided by purchaser — \$3,585.00

B. Direct cremation with particleboard or fiberboard container provided by our funeral establishment — \$3,800.00

C. Direct cremation with casket selected from our funeral establishment — \$3,585.00 plus cost of casket

D. Direct cremation with highest priced casket acceptable for cremation (Marsellus Masterpiece, solid mahogany) — \$36,663.00

E. Medical Examiner's Fee — \$100.00

F. Enhanced Cremation Fee (250 lbs. and up) — \$50.00 for each 50 lbs. over 250

State and local laws do not require a casket for direct cremation. If you want to arrange a direct cremation, you can use an alternative container. Alternative containers encase the body and can be made of materials like fiberboard or composition materials (with or without an outside covering). The containers we provide are made of particleboard.

XII. Infant Service Packages

Infant Burial

The charge for the Infant Service includes all the professional services of our licensed funeral directors and other personnel. Also included are the service vehicles for transfer of the remains to the funeral home and the cemetery; use of our preparation room for embalming, preservation, sanitation, minor restoration, cosmetology, dressing, casketing, and other care and sheltering of the remains; a casket/vault combination and a graveside service.

Love and Cherish Casket: 19 inch — Casket \$815.00 + Basic Services \$1,200.00 = Total \$2,015.00

24 inch — Casket \$950.00 + Basic Services \$1,200.00 = Total \$2,150.00

31 inch — Casket \$1,250.00 + Basic Services \$1,500.00 = Total \$2,750.00

Infant Cremation — \$1,150.00

The charge for a Direct Infant Cremation includes all the professional services of our licensed funeral directors and staff. Also included is the service vehicle for transfer of the remains to the funeral home; the fee for cremation; use of our preparation room for sheltering remains prior and during any medical examination to obtain the cremation certificate.

Charges for visitation or viewing, flowers, additional funeral merchandise or services, clergy and/or musician honorariums, cemetery lots and opening/closing fees, vault company weekend or holiday fees, certified copies of the death certificate, other cash advances and sales tax are not included in this package price.

XIII. Cash Advance Items/Special Charges

As a courtesy to our families, J. T. Fisher Funeral Services will place all cash advance items on the contract. Payment for these items is due at the time the arrangements are made. Cash, check or insurance assignment is accepted. We also accept all major credit cards; however, there will be a 3% fee assessed for all cash advance items placed on credit cards.

Families rendering insurance policies for payment will be charged a 5% advance insurance fee and \$26.00 for the bank wire fee.

Cash advances include, but are not limited to, items such as certified copies of the death certificate, clergy and/or musician honorariums, cemetery lots, cemetery opening/closing fees, vault company weekend or holiday fees, police escorts, airline shipping expenses, out of town funeral home charges or medical examiner's fee.

XIV. General Payment Information

Payment Policy

Payment is due no later than forty-eight hours prior to funeral, memorial, or cremation service. Payments may be made in cash, by check, by credit card, or by an approved insurance assignment.

Disclosure

- 1) **Dangerous Diseases:** It is our company policy not to embalm, cremate or allow viewing of any body known or suspected to have Creutzfeldt-Jakob Disease. Neither embalming nor cremation will kill this deadly disease. Smallpox is another deadly disease and is highly contagious. Therefore, any body with smallpox will not be embalmed or allowed viewing in order to protect public health and the spread of the disease.
- 2) **ID Viewing:** It is our company policy that when a body has been autopsied, and an ID viewing is requested, the body must be embalmed. Due to the invasive nature of an autopsy, there is no way to control the leakage of bodily fluids and blood, which present a public health hazard to those family members and our staff outside the preparation area. In addition, any body with a contagious disease must be embalmed for a family ID viewing. Number 2 listed above also applies to organ donation.

Note: In order to comply with OSHA guidelines for a safe working environment these are necessary restrictions.
