Angelene Belinda Neal Williams, fondly known as Angie, was born June 16, 1951 in Lego, WV to the late Joseph E. & Frances Hansberry Neal. She received her education from the public school system and graduated from Stratton High School in WV. She was a licensed cosmetologist and licensed clinical nursing assistant. During her career, she retired from the state of New York working with the mentally disabled from 1972 - 1989 and continued with her gifts in the field of nursing. Upon relocation to the state of Virginia, she worked for Heritage Commons Nursing Home along with managing private duty assignments. Angelene was a loving mother, faithful wife, and dear friend. She was a dedicated member of St. Paul Deliverance Christian Center under the direction of Apostle Eddie & Pastor Paula Dunlap. She served as the president of the Nursing Board, president of the Missionary Board, director of the Sunshine Choir, and was the well-known "volun-told potato salad maker" for all church functions. She served as the backup singer in her purple sequin dress and platinum blonde wig for the bishop's birthday bash singing Call Me by Aretha Franklin. Angelene was also well-known for her daily antics and for her part in the St. Paul church play, "Let's Get Churchy" at The Holy True Church of the Divine. Those who remember the play can recall her key lines of "sword in the bosom" and "I use-ta-be sistant pasa," as well as fighting in the church pulpit with Missionary Estelle and Missionary Sadie.
