Mrs. Annie Laurie Simmons Talley of the Arcadia Heights Community transitioned from this earth to reward on Thursday, February 5, 2015. She was a native of Henrico County, Virginia who was born on July 5, 1918. She married the late Bishop Thomas E. Talley and they reared two daughters - Beverly Renata and Talitha Yvonne Parker. Mrs. Talley is a graduate of Virginia Union University (1942). She taught First Graders at Chestnut Street School and Special Education classes at several schools in Portsmouth Public Schools for a total of 38 years. For over 50 years, she was a very active member in the United Holy Church of America and attended Gospel Light in Newport News where her husband was the pastor. In later years she attended Twine Memorial Temple (Portsmouth) and Holy Temple (Chesapeake) churches. She was trustee, Sunday School teacher, sponsored many fund raisers, and served in many other capacities. Survivors include two daughters Beverly and Talitha (Nathaniel Parker); a granddaughter Jennifer L. Lee. Many nieces, nephews and extended family will miss her.

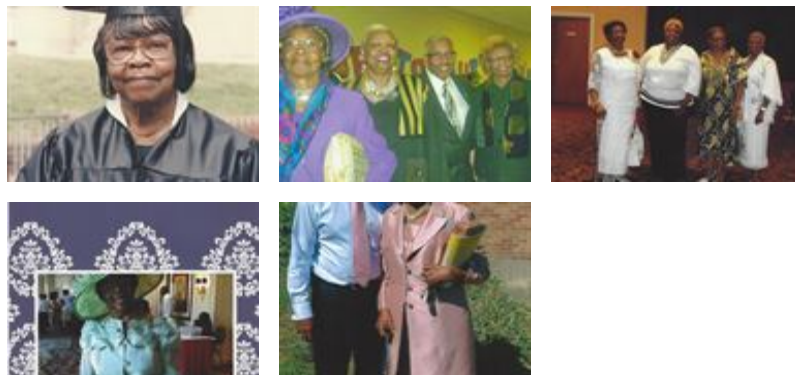
