Antoinette Marie Davis was born November 28, 1924 in Brooklyn, New York. She had a two brothers and one sister and was greatly influenced by her mother who loved the Lord and instilled the same in Antoinette.

She grew up in New York until she met the love of her life, a young Petty Officer named Samuel Davis Jr. The couple moved to Newport, Rhode Island where she had three children before moving to Virginia and expanded the family by three additional children.

In Virginia Beach, Antoinette rose to head cashier of a larger grocery chain before establishing her own business "Armies Cleaning Service": Antoinette was known for her keen business sense and was unencumbered by worldly possessions. Her greatest strength came from her strong belief in love for Lord Jesus Christ She shared the Word of God to whomever she met and was known as a woman of wisdom.

During her later years she carried the same zeal while remaining active in her local fellowship until she was unable to attend services. Antoinette believed God would heal her over conventional medical intervention. She outlived the doctors prognosis for her life by several years until her ultimate healing - when God called her home.

She is preceded in death by her soul mate, Samuel Davis, Jr. and her three Siblings.

Antoinette leaves behind to cherish her memory, three daughters, Melahi, Cynthia and Carol; eight sons, Moses, David, Aaron, Paul, Carl, Phillip, Charles, Stephen and a host of grandchildren, great grandchildren, nieces, nephews, other relatives and .friends.
