Arthur Lee Phillips, affectionately known as (Cocky Joe), was born on May 2, 1944, in Seaboard, North Carolina to Mary M. Phillips who later married Alfred Pair and moved to the Mount Herman area of Portsmouth, Virginia.

Arthur graduated from I.C. Norcom in 1964. He attended Norfolk State University and was a devoted alumnus. Arthur joined the Air Force and received an honorable discharge. He was a Past Commander at the American Legion Post 190 in Portsmouth, Virginia.

At an early age, he was baptized and became an active member of Mount Herman Baptist Temple under the guidance of the late Rev. Waters. In August 1977, he married Sheila Faircloth, and they later joined New First Baptist Church Taylorsville (NFBCT).

Arthur retired from Norfolk Naval Shipyard after 30 years of service where he worked as an Electrical Engineering Analyst. 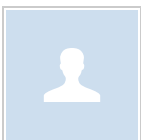
