March 27, 1958 - April 12, 2016

On Tuesday evening April 12, 2016 at 5:28 pm, Barney Jerome Hall, slipped peacefully away to be at home with the Lord. Barney was born on March 27, 1958 in Keysville, Virginia to Frank S. Hall and Deleva G. Hall. Barney was the second of two children. The family moved to Norfolk, Virginia and he joined Norfolk United Methodist Church at an early age and in his later years he became a member of Mount Sinai Church in Portsmouth, Virginia under the leadership of Pastor Richie Sessoms, Sr. Barney attended school in Norfolk and graduated from Granby High School. Barney continued his studies at Salisbury University in Maryland, after which he joined the United States Navy and served his country faithfully for ten years. After completing his tour of duty in the Navy, Barney was employed on the staff of the Norfolk Sheriff's Department and worked for a long time in the Transportation Department. Barney also did further studies at Tidewater Community College where he received a certificate for Heating & Air Conditioning and a certificate for his CDL license.
