



Bobby Lee Hayes, Jr.

April 7, 1958 - November 2, 2025

Mr. Bobby Lee Hayes, Jr., age 67, passed away peacefully on November 2, 2025, in Chesapeake, Virginia. A devoted husband, father, grandfather, brother, and uncle, he leaves behind a legacy of service, faith, and unwavering love for his family.

Born on April 7, 1958, in Bowling Green, Kentucky, Bobby was the beloved son of the late Bobby Hayes and Caroline Hayes. He was also preceded in death by his cherished grandmother, Lily Thompson. From an early age, Bobby demonstrated a strong sense of duty and compassion—qualities that would define his life's journey. He accepted Christ at the age of 8 at State Street Baptist Church in Bowling Green KY.

In 1979, Bobby answered the call to serve his country by enlisting in the United States Navy. Over the course of two decades of honorable service, he built a distinguished career marked by dedication and integrity. He retired in 1999 aboard the USS Stennis in San Diego, California, having earned the respect of his peers and superiors alike. He graduated from St. Leo University with a Bachelor's degree in Sociology and Religious Studies in 1996 and received a Masters of Education from Old Dominion University in 2002.

Following his military retirement, Bobby continued to live a life rooted in faith and community. A faithful member of DC Church and an active participant in

The Gideons International organization, he found purpose in sharing his beliefs and supporting others through spiritual outreach.

Bobby's greatest joy came from the time he spent with his family. He is lovingly remembered by his wife, Kasandra of 43 years; their children Cherie and Justen; and grandchildren Kamyron, Kristopher, Kandyce, and Isaiah. His siblings—Cynthia Hampton, Sharon Blakey, and Steven Edison— as well as nieces and nephews also mourn his passing while cherishing countless memories shared over the years.

Those who knew Bobby will remember him as kind-hearted and caring—a man deeply committed to those he loved. Whether offering guidance as a father or sharing laughter as a grandfather or brother, he brought warmth and strength into every relationship.

May his memory bring comfort to all who knew him and continue to inspire lives grounded in love and service.
