The God of Wisdom reached into our midst and called our beloved Cecil Ruton Vaughan to eternal rest in His Heavenly Kingdom on Saturday morning January 30, 2016.

Born in Portsmouth, VA, on October 10, 1943 to Bernice A. Pearson and the late Preston D. Vaughan, he was educated in the Portsmouth Public Schools and attended I.C. Norcom High School. He accepted Christ at an early age and was well versed in the scriptures.

In 1974, Cecil organized the Rock Church in Tennessee where he was the pastor. He had a radio broadcasting station called "WARO" Reaching Out. In 1976, he started a school where students from kindergarten through 12th grade were graded with excellence of achievements. He traveled as a missionary to such countries as St. Martin, St. Cruix, Jenya, Nairobi, Mombesa. India, Artic. and Curacao. spending at least a month in each. He was an excellent teacher and facilitator.

His favorite scripture was Phillipian 3. His favorite songs were "Beautiful Garden of Prayer", "Tis so sweet to Trust in Jesus". and "Praise The Lord". He wrote a song called the "Path of Life" Psalm 6:11.

He leaves to cherish his memory four sons; Michael, Kyle (Brianna). Christopher and Carlton; one daughter, Cynthia; his mother, Bernice P. Vaughan; two brothers, Preston D.Vaughan and Trammel Vaughan (Jewel); four grandchildren, Kyle. Jr., Wesley, Nathaniel and Brittany; four great-grandchildren: four aunts, Gloria P Williamson. Maude P Green, Vera Pearson and Ann Vaughan; an uncle, Winston R. Pearson and a host of nieces, nephews, cousins and close friends. Cecil was predeceased by his father, Preston D. Vaughan and brother, Dwight Vaughan.
