CHARLES EARNFST WILLIAMS, JR., was born February 7, 1949 to the late Charles Earnest, Sr. and Jean Odessa Williams. He departed this life and entered eternal joy on Wednesday, March 21, 2018 at Virginia Beach General Hospital.

Charles grew up in Portsmouth, VA, and was educated in the Portsmouth Public School System. After graduating from I.C. Norcom High School, he joined the United States Marine Corps and served in the Vietnam War where he received the National Defense Service Medal, the Vietnam Service Medal, the Vietnam Campaign Medal, and the Combat Action Ribbon.
