Charles Henry Wilson, 64, transitioned from labor to reward peacefully on December 13, 2011. He was a native of Portsmouth, Virginia born to the late Bishop John Henry Wilson and Susana Rogers Wilson. Charles was educated in Portsmouth Schools and Tidewater Community College. He later joined the United States Army where he served in the Vietnam War. Charles was honorably discharged. After serving in the U. S. Army, he relocated back to Portsmouth. He became a member in April 1997 and later a Deacon of Mount Zinia Holiness Church where he served until his health began to fail.
