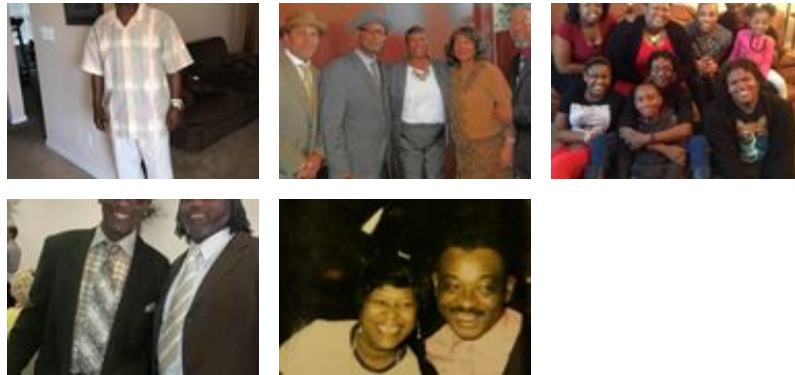


I have known Chuckie 55 plus years very good friends everytime we saw each other we talked about times he will be truly missed R.I.H. my brother.
