Constance Diane Cross, departed this life on Tuesday, February 16, 2016, surrounded by her loving family. She was born April 2, 1948 in Portsmouth, Virginia, to the late Ellis and Delane “Jenkins” Richardson.

Constance (Connie/Diane) as she was affectionately known by others was loved and respected by many and was a mother to many. She was formerly married to the late Cecil R. Cross, Sr., and to this union three sons were born.
