On November 16, 1968, Crystal Evette Pierce entered this world as the second daughter born to the late Janice Munford Pierce and Christopher Columbus Pierce. Contrary to belief of many, she was the “Younger” sister to Natalee. Crystal quietly slipped away from us in her home on November 20, 2024.

Crystal attended Portsmouth Public Schools and graduated from I.C. Norcom High School in 1987. Initially, she began studying at Old Dominion University in Norfolk, Va., but she ultimately obtained a Bachelor of Arts degree in Business from Virginia Wesleyan University in 2006.

Crystal was raised in a Christian home, and she joined Grove Baptist Church at an early age. As a youth, she sang in the Junior choir, and she also served as the treasurer of the Sunday School. Crystal was a lifelong member of Grove, having remained an active member until her demise.

On March 24, 1997, Crystal acquired a different role... that of a mother. Her only daughter, Cara Elise was born, and she became Crystal’s world. As Cara grew and matured, so did their bond. So much so that Crystal gave Cara her beloved Chevy Tahoe, “Big Red” truck.

With her infectious smile and personality, it’s no surprise that Crystal chose to

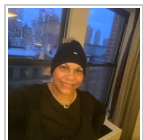

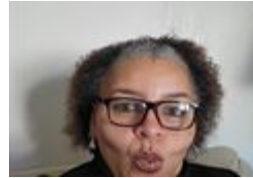
