He remained there until his retirement after forty three years of service. He supervised many of his co-workers and developed many friendships during his tenure. To this union three wonderful sons were born: Curtis Quincy Hall, Jr., Dante Lamonte Hall, and Jermaine Renaldo Hall. Curtis loved his wife and sons dearly. He was a lovingly husband and a devoted father to his sons. He was a great provider and friend. He talked with his brother and sister regularly.
