January 31, 1951 - November 9, 2017

Darnell Johnson, 66, passed on Thursday, November 9, 2017. He was born in Henderson, N.C. to the late Julius Johnson, Sr. and Winnie Harrison Thornton. He was a member of Third Baptist Church in Portsmouth, VA. He loved the Lord, the Dallas Cowboys, Elizabeth City State University, and his family. Darnell was a dedicated educator, bible-scholar, chaplain of the Portsmouth City Jail and proud member of the Alpha Phi Alpha fraternity, the New Men for Progress, and I. C. Norcom Class of '69. He was in the Portsmouth Public School system for thirty years where he served as a math teacher, assistant principal, community school liaison, assistant band director at Manor High, and as principal of The Alternative School and Churchland Middle School. After retirement, he served at Hampton University as Assistant Dean of Education and at ECSU as Chair of the Math Department and an Endowed professor.

Darnell is survived by his wife Dr. Stephanie Denise Bailey Johnson. Together they had one daughter, Dawn; 3 grandchildren - Faith, Steffi, and Maeah; his siblings, Florence and Bernard, stepmother, Vashti Johnson along with a host of nieces, nephews, and friends.
