He developed his craft as the minister of music at Mount Ararat Christian United Church. He loved to make people laugh; he was known as the family entertainer. He carried his sidekick (harmonica) wherever he went and would perform at various functions such as weddings, retirement and birthdays. He enhanced his musical skills with his harmonica when he released 3 CD's; Manor on High, In Your Presence and A King Is Born, Christmas CD. He was currently employed at Veterans Administration department as a Housing Support specialist for 14 years and enjoyed helping veterans find a place to live.

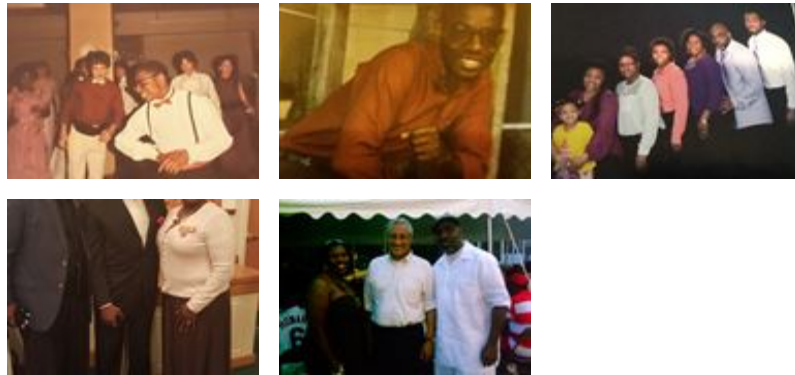
