Donald N. Massey, along with his twin, Ronald, was born February 2, 1950 to the late Theodore and Addie Mae Massey in Brooklyn, New York. Donald was the youngest of two brothers and three sisters. Preceding him in death was a brother, Thomas Massey and a sister, Patricia Fowler. Donald departed this life on February 14, 2009 at Sentara Bayside Hospital, Virginia Beach, Virginia.

Donnie was the youngest of six children. As a young child he was a member of St. George Episcopal Church in Brooklyn, New York where he made his confirmation. He later rededicated his life to Christ.

He was a Boy Scout and earned several merit badges. He attended Boy's High in Brooklyn, New York. Donnie had a love for music, playing chess, art, and movies. As soon as he came of age, Donnie enlisted in the Armed Services (Company C, 2nd Battalion Airmobile, 12th Cavalry) and received several recognitions and medals for heroism while serving in the Vietnam War. He received the Vietnam Service Medal with four Bronze Service Stars, the Army Commendation Medal with "V" Device, Vietnam Combat Certificate, Republic of Vietnam Campaign Medal, Air Medal, Sharpshooter qualification badge with Rifle bars, Republic of Vietnam Gallantry Cross, Unit Citation with Palm and one Service Bar after completing his tour of duty.

Donnie leaves to cherish his memories to his twin, Ronald (Denise) Massey and two sisters, Jean Weston and Lydia (Fajor) Foriest, a host of nieces, nephews, and other relatives and friends.
