Dr. Shera “Ann” Dixon Parker, 64, passed away on April 28, 2015 surrounded by her family. She was born on April 11, 1951 to James W. Dixon, Sr. and the late Queen Esther Dixon. She quietly slipped away to join her mother and her late sister, Carolyn Dixon Coppedge in heaven after fighting a courageous two year battle against cancer. Dr. Parker graduated from I. C. Norcom High School in 1969. She furthered her education by attaining a Bachelor’s degree in Special Education from D. C. Teachers College, a Masters from Old Dominion University in 1997, and a Doctorate Degree in Special Education from Regent University in 2009. Dr. Parker was very committed and loved teaching special needs children for over 40 years. She taught in both Portsmouth Public Schools and the District of Columbia Public Schools. Dr. Parker was a loving and dedicated mother to her three children; Elbert Parker, Jr. and Shantel Parker of Washington, D. C. and Sherese Parker of Itta Bena, Mississippi. She also dearly loved her three little angels, her granddaughters, Anjanae, Ryin, and Andraya, all of Wahington, DC. She is survived by her father, James W. I love you mom and always will!

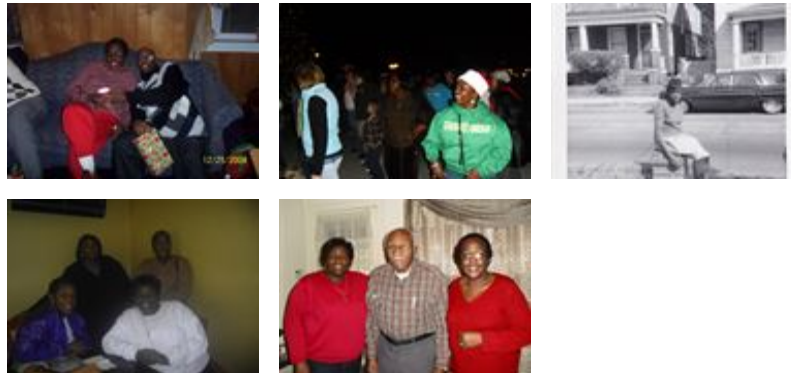

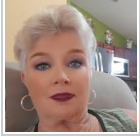
