On Wednesday, September 24, 2014, surrounded by her family, Missionary Earnestine Ward Spires went home to be with the Lord. Earnestine, born on February 9, 1943, was the oldest daughter of the Late Elder Aaron & Missionary Catherine Ward. At a young age, you could see the loving and quiet spirit that Earnestine possessed. While in her teens, Earnestine accepted Christ as her personal Savior. Her love for the Lord and people was expressed in everything she did. She had an extraordinary gift for helping others. Earnestine was also blessed with the gift of writing. Earnestine attended Crestwood High School where she received numerous awards for academic achievement. She was honored as Salutatorian of her graduating class of 1961 and was awarded a State Teachers' Scholarship to attend Norfolk State University. She matriculated from Norfolk State University with a Bachelor of Science Degree in English Education. Earnestine was joined in Holy Matrimony to Eugene Spires on July 20, 1963. To this union was born four children: Anita, Michael, Valerie, and Christopher. Earnestine was brought up in the Church of God in Christ where she was active as YPWW Chairlady, Sunday School and Sunshine Band Teacher and Usher Board Member. She was also a Licensed Missionary. After relocating to Griffin Georgia, Earnestine became a member of Mount Olive Outreach Ministries Church where she was re-baptized as an expression of her deep religious conviction. Although Earnestine was very active in church affairs, she never

neglected her home. She was a devoted wife, mother and grandmother. Earnestine was preceded in death by her husband; Elder Eugene Spires; oldest daughter, Anita Marie Spires Goodman; and youngest son, Christopher Spires .
