Edward Pinckney affectionally known as Ed, Diddie, Plug, Easy, Uncle Easy, Pop-Pop, and simply known by his grandsons as "Pop" passed away on October 19, 2025 at home surrounded by loved ones.

Edward was born on July 26, 1932 in Darlington, South Carolina to the late David Pinckney Sr. and Marie Mack Pinckney. 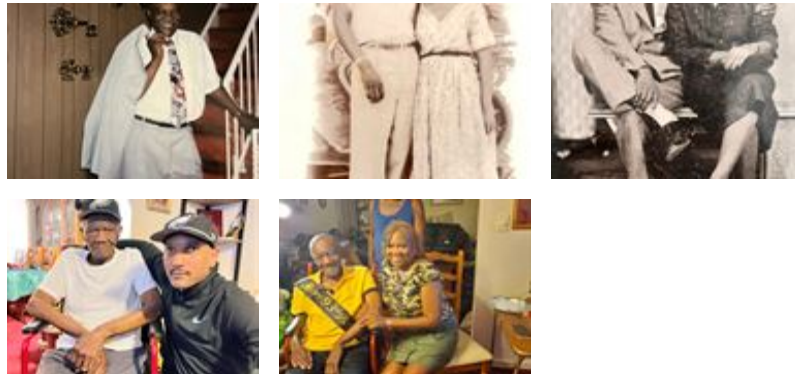
