April 29, 1929 - February 3, 2009

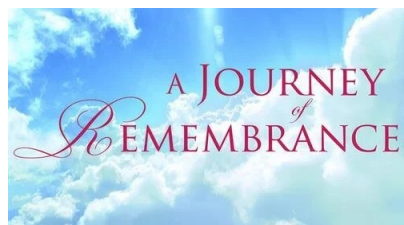

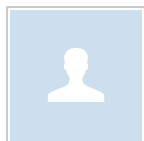

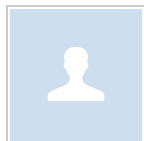
