March 6, 1939 - July 28, 2016

Ernest Linwood Cox, 77, was called to be with the Lord on Thursday, July 28, 2016. Born on March 6, 1939 in Norfolk County to the late McKinley and Pearlie Cox, he was a native of Portsmouth, Virginia. Affectionately known by the community as 'Nub', he was a devoted and loving father, brother, grandfather, uncle, father-in-law and friend. He married Bernice Thomas and through this union, one daughter was birthed. Later in life, Ernest was also blessed with one son and two other daughters. He received his early education at Churchland schools and Crestwood High School. His job for more than 30 years allowed him to be a dedicated and loyal employee at Norshipco from which he retired. In his spare time, Nub enjoyed watching western TV shows, game shows and Sanford & Son -- often jokingly asking his nieces and nephews, "You know Lamont?" 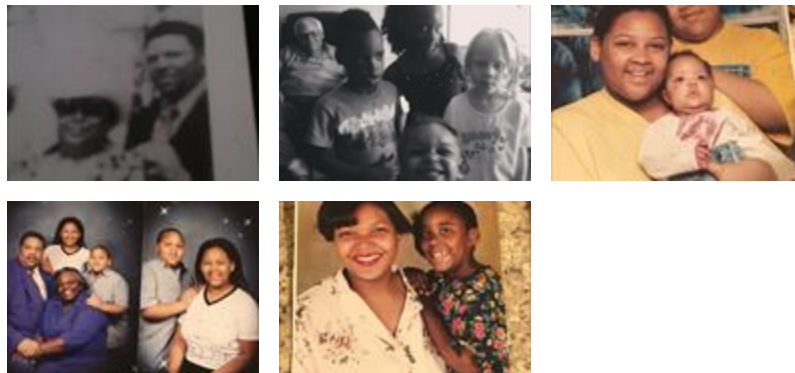
