She was employed as School Secretary for Southwestern Elementary School in Chesapeake, VA 1960 - 1968 and I.C. Norcom High School in Portsmouth, VA 1968 - 1970.

Ethel gave her life to Christ at any early age. She joined Grove Baptist Church in 1938 and remained a faithful member until her health began to decline. She served as the first Church Secretary from 1966 to 1983 under the pastorates of Reverend Ralph Reavis and Reverend Freeman Rhodes.
