Eugene Hinton, Sr. was born on October 28, 1934 in Brooklyn, NY to parents Royal and Dora Hinton. He was the eighth of nine children. Eugene's education went as far as high school until he enlisted into the Marine Corps and became a drill sergeant. He was committed and proudly served his country. He traveled all over the world and always had great stories to share about his experience as a marine.

In 1955, he met Patricia Ann Isles, also from Brooklyn, New York. They fell deeply in love and made the commitment to each other in marriage that same year. From their loving union, came along 2 children. His beloved son Eugene and beloved daughter Tina. Four years after the birth of Tina, Eugene, Sr. decided to leave the marines to be with his family.

Some time later, Eugene began working as a conductor for the Transit Authority in Brooklyn and Queens. He worked for the transit authority for over 30 years. Sadly, a month before he was to retire, Patricia became ill and died in November of 1988, leaving Eugene and the family devastated.

Eugene joined Mount Carmel Baptist Church in August 1993 and was active in the Trustee Ministry, a cook in the Men's Fellowship for many years, a graduate of the Discipleship Evangelism Ministry, and also sang in the Male Choir. 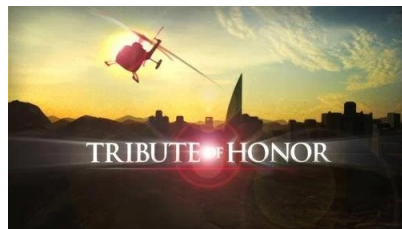
