Evangelist Missionary Barbara Jean Cutler committed her life to the Lord at an early age. She was the First Lady of St. James Church of God In Christ for 39 years where she held many positions: President of the Young Adult Choir, Senior Choir Director, President of the Sewing Circle, President of the Missionary Circle, Y.W.C.C. Teacher, Vacation Bible School Art and Craft Instructor, Sponsor of the Back to School Supplies Giveaway, Home and Foreign Mission Teacher and 4th Sunday Rally Day Chair Lady. In the VA Second Jurisdiction she was the former President of the Portsmouth District Choir and Sewing Circle. She was the President of

the Minister and Deacon Wives.
