



Faye Shirley Rountree

May 4, 1954 - November 29, 2025

Faye Shirley Rountree was born on May 4, 1954, to the late Roland T. and Gladys E. Rountree, the sixth of twelve children. From the very beginning, Faye's life was an example of faith, perseverance, and triumph. Born with cerebral palsy, doctors once said she would not live past the age of 18—but God had other plans. She defied every expectation and lived a remarkable 71 years, proving that her life would never be measured by limitations, but by courage and determination.

Wearing special braces and shoes (provided by the March of Dimes) on both legs, Faye learned to walk at the age of six. This milestone was just one of many ways she demonstrated her strong will and determined spirit. In 1975, she graduated from Deep Creek High School and the Kirk-Cone Rehabilitation Center. She also found connection through Camp Civitan for individuals with disabilities in Chesapeake, Virginia.

As an adult, Faye embraced independence and lived on her own for many years, a source of great pride for both herself and her family. She enjoyed writing, typing, reading, and listening to music. Her thoughtful nature was

demonstrated by remembering family members birthdays and milestones. Though time eventually changed her physical abilities and mobility, it never diminished her spirit. In her later years, she resided at Chesapeake Nursing and Rehabilitation Facility, where she was cared for with dignity and compassion.

Faye was preceded in death by three siblings: Carolyn V. Paulding, Melvin T. Rountree, Bruce Rountree (Annie) and leaves cherished memories with eight siblings: Lawrence Rountree (Diane), Loretta Rountree, Gladys Marie Henryhand (Lawrence), Miles Rountree (Jacquelyn), Sharon Wilson (Wilbur), Darlene Branch, Joy Haskins (Kenneth), and Roy Rountree. She is also fondly remembered by aunts, uncles, a host of nieces, nephews, cousins, and extended family members. Including her devoted caretaker, Mary Gatling Griffin.

Faye's life reminds us that strength is not measured by physical ability but by the heart, the will, and the courage to keep going. Her journey was one of perseverance, quiet joy, and faith-filled endurance. Though she now rests in heaven, her legacy lives on in the lives she touched and the inspiration she leaves behind.
