June 1, 1922 - December 29, 2021

Florine Whitehurst Evans, having been blessed to live 99 years, passed away peacefully at home in Manassas, VA on Wednesday, December 29, 2021. She was born in Zuni VA on June 1, 1922, the daughter of the late Frank Daniel Whitehurst and Mattie Jennings Whitehurst. She had 6 siblings, Marshall, Frank, Ralph and Earl Whitehurst, Mildred Chapman and Maxine Harris.

Florine was educated in Isle of Wight County schools and graduated from Isle of Wight Training School. She was employed as a housekeeper for several families in Windsor and later worked as a school cafeteria supervisor.
