



Fredda Samantha Bryan

September 30, 1965 - June 1, 2017

On June 1, 2017, Fredda Samantha Blackman Bryan was called home to be with our Lord. She was born on September 30th 1965, at Camp Lejune, North Carolina, to May Tagupa Blackman a native Hawaiian and Freddie Samuel Blackman a U.S. Marine from Dallas Texas. She was the youngest child having an older brother Dane and sister Randolyn. The family lived on several military bases in the U.S. before settling in Oceanside California, near Camp Pendleton Marine Corps Base in 1976. It was Oceanside that Fredda called her hometown. Fredda attended Jefferson Jr. High School and graduated from El Camino High School.

In 1983, shortly thereafter she worked several years at LaCosta Resort and Spa before joining the Navy in February of 1987. Fredda retired in 2009 with the rank of Senior Chief Petty Officer. Upon retirement Fredda went to work for the American Cancer Society, where she was a dedicated champion for the cause of Breast Cancer Awareness. She was a Breast Cancer survivor, while in recent years living with stage 4 Cancer.

She leaves behind her only son D'Angelo Applewhite of Chesapeake, VA, father Francis "Daddy" Ferguson, of Oceanside, CA, brother Freddie Patrick Blackman of New York, NY, sister Randolyn Anderson of Atlanta, GA, nieces Trina Jenkins of Denver, CO., Octavia Ellison of Houston, TX, Jasmine Walker of Atlanta, GA., and seven great nieces and nephews, aunt Beverly Blackman of Dallas, TX., God parents Samuel and Thelma Phillips of Chesapeake, VA., Godson Eric Robert Hunter of North Hollywood, CA., and a host of friends, colleagues and loved ones. Fredda was preceded in death by her mother May Tagupa Blackman, father Freddie Samuel Blackman, a niece Michelle E. Blackwell and nephew Joaquin G. Pruitt.

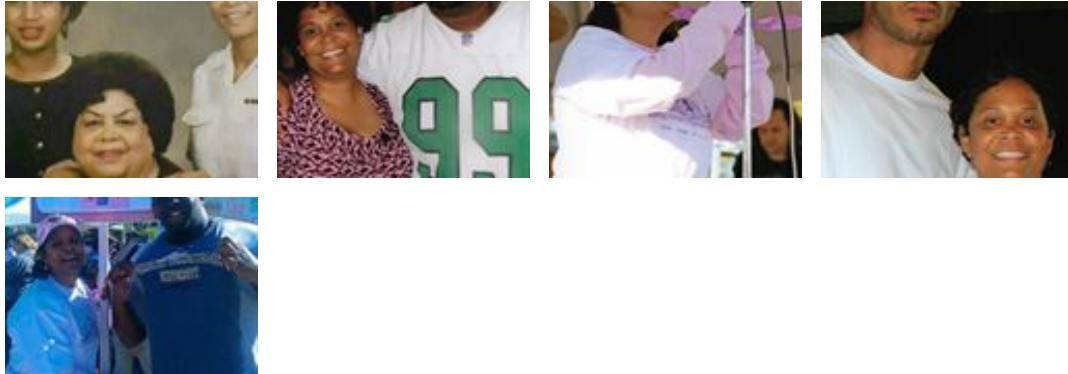

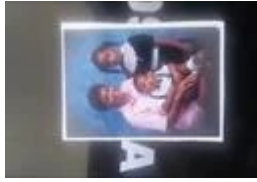
