January 23, 1944 - June 15, 2018

George Albert Jeter was born on January 23, 1944 in Stafford County, Virginia to Evelyn Reed Jeter and Thomas Warren Jeter who predeceased him.

George was one of the first students to integrate Stafford High School and was a stand-out athlete, known even then for his outgoing personality.

After high school, he joined the United States Navy where he served honorably, and thereafter served for seventeen years in the United States Navy Reserve. George worked at the Norfolk Naval Shipyard and retired after forty-two years as a planner and estimator.

He was a faithful member of New Testament Church, Portsmouth, Virginia where he was a vital part of many ministries. He was the church maintenance man for years, the church van driver for years, ushered every Sunday; and thirty-five years ago, cut down all of the trees on the church property to allow for a parking lot. He was "a giant of a man who will truly be missed at THE MENT", according to his Pastor, Bishop Jerome Williams.

A skilled fisherman, and an avid, repeat, avid Redskins fan, George was dedicated to everything he pursued and was the consummate "Mr. Fix It"! At church, as at home and in the community, he was willing to do whatever it took to make things better for others. He was a proud, dutiful member of the American Legion Post 190.

His greatest love was that of his family - his daughters, Frances Georgette Jeter-Harrell and Jill Brenette Jeter (deceased); and his two grandchildren, Brett Harrell, Jr. and Bria Harrell. He was a dear brother to James T. Jeter

(Lorraine), Marietta, GA; Mary Ann Marsh (deceased); Robert T. Jeter (Valerie), Hampton, VA; Rudolph H. Jeter, Richmond, VA and John C. Jeter, Fredericksburg, VA. He is also survived by numerous nieces, nephews, cousins and godchildren. He also had dear friends, who were like family in Jerome Smith, Robert Randall and Celestine Cousins. George had an infectious personality and rare sense of humor, never having met a stranger. His countless friends along with his family will miss him dearly.
