Gladys was born on July 3, 1927 in Portsmouth, VA to The late Julius and Lena Dale Easter Dupree. Gladys was educated in the Portsmouth Public School System. She was baptized at Ebenezer Baptist Church in Portsmouth, VA. Gladys met and married William H. Evans, Sr. in 1945. She was a stay at home mom who devoted her life to raising and nurturing her children. She was an excellent cook, her famous “sweet potatoes jacks, rice pudding, potatoes salad and homemade potatoes rolls” were the talk of the neighborhood, because she prepared these dishes with lots of love. 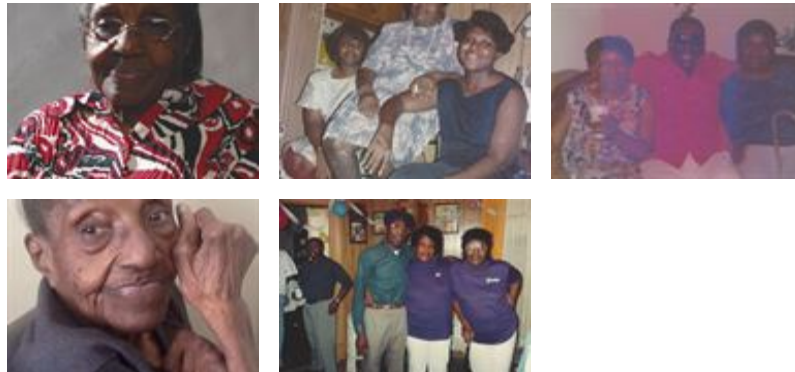
