



Gloria Jean Creekmur

August 13, 1940 - February 27, 2024

Gloria Jean McCabe Creekmur peacefully departed this world surrounded by her loved ones on February 27, 2024, in the comfort of her home. She graced the earth on August 13, 1940, born to loving parents Frank and Gladys P. McCabe of Norfolk, Virginia.

Educated at Bennett College and a graduate of Norfolk State University, Gloria dedicated over 40 years to teaching in the Norfolk City School District, specializing in biology and Adult Basic Education. A lifelong learner, she remained committed to expanding her knowledge and acquiring new skills. She was an active member of the Booker T. Washington High School Class of '58 and of her local Bennett College Alumni chapter, the Tidewater Belles.

Her passion for Black history was evident in her involvement with church plays and programs, as well as her support for local Black history exhibits and events within her community. Gloria instilled her love for the arts in her children, ensuring that they were enriched with piano, ballet, tap, and art lessons, and exposed them to plays, concerts and museums.

Known for her nurturing and caring spirit, Gloria was revered by many as a maternal figure. She cherished her family and found joy in frequent gatherings and reunions.

A faithful member and Deaconess at Divine Baptist Church, Gloria served diligently in various ministries including the Senior Ministry, Senior Choir, Senior Missionary Board, Divine Baptist Church Youth Ministry, Youth Choir and was the founder of the Divine Baptist Church Scholarship Fund. Recently, she rejoined her childhood home church, First Church of Christ Holiness, USA.

Gloria leaves behind a lasting impact on her community, described as a "mark that will never be erased." Her family is committed to continuing her legacy of serving as change agents for Christ.

For over 62 years, Gloria shared a profound bond with her loving husband John Creekmur. Her legacy lives on through her children, Kimberly Creekmur and Melodye May (Demond), granddaughter Lauryn Noelle May, her cherished bonus son Lloyd Daniel, special bonus granddaughters Nyjala Davis and Jada Goodman, and Goddaughters Kelly Clark Brown and Ashka Everette, along with her beloved pet "Precious" the Pomeranian. She embodied love for her nieces, nephews, cousins, friends, neighbors, and church family. Gloria was preceded in death by her precious sister Lenora Drummond. Also left to cherish her memory are Frank McCabe Jr. (Mildred, deceased), Gladys Riddick (Phillip), and Keith McCabe (Christine).

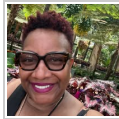
