Gregory attended Woodrow Wilson High School and Manor High School in Portsmouth, VA. He also went to trade school to become an auto mechanic. Crow could frequently be found working on cars on evenings and weekends. He worked in the Trucking/Construction industry for over 45 years driving Tandem Dump Trucks. Three (3) notable companies throughout Crow's career include Womack Construction, Paxton Construction, and Inlet Construction.

Gregory married his first wife, Renita Hooks (Coot), on February 3, 1975. His two (2) beautiful daughters (LaKeisha and Catrisha) were born of this 10-year union. He also loved wearing hats. You would rarely see him without a hat whether he was casually dressed, wearing his Sunday's best, riding around in his dump truck, or working on a car. Crow could literally fix anything. He wouldn't stop until he found a way to fix whatever it was, even if he had to 'Crow Rig' it. Crow wasn't big on football or basketball; however, he really loved watching wrestling. WWE Monday Night RAW is how he spent Monday evenings for many years. This is something he thoroughly enjoyed watching with his mother before she passed away in 2019. Crow could cook, too. He would get in the kitchen and whip up some of his family's famous recipes. Crow loved his family and was so proud of his daughters and his grandchildren.

Gregory was preceded in death by his parents, Edward and Doris Sawyer, and his oldest sister, Linda Twine.
