Henry Mason Williams was born on November 2, 1962 to the late Calvin and Elsie Williams. He was born and raised in Jamaica, Queens, NY.

Mason attended elementary school PS 40, IS 8 and graduated from Flushing H.S. He joined the US Navy in December of 1979. While serving in the Navy he was involved in a serious vehicle accident while on duty. He was released from active duty and honorably discharged. He returned to NY and worked at various companies until he relocated to Virginia in 2003 to work for the Ford Motor Company.

After 2 surgeries in Jan. 2017 and battling his illness for several months, on Thursday, May 25th 2017 Mason succumbed to his illness.

Mason leaves to mourn his passing his son Yahel Elijah Williams, 22 of Brooklyn, NY, and Ashley Tamara Monique Williams, 21 of Richmond, VA; and 1 grandson Jordan Xavier Quick, 3 months. Throughout the years he has been a father figure to many and recently filled that role for Jamiahia Kidd of Hampton, VA. Mason was the fifth of eight children and leaves a void in the hearts of his seven siblings Gwen Cooper, Anderson, SC; Jacqueline Williams, Queens, NY; Evelyn Williams, Queens, NY; Calvin Williams Jr.; Rayetta Thomas, Chesapeake, VA; Anthony Williams, Valley Stream, NY; Martin Williams, Queens, NY. He will also be greatly missed by his two

brothers-in-law Duane Cooper, Anderson SC and John Thomas, Chesapeake, VA and one sister-in-law, Chakie Williams, Chesapeake, VA; his many nieces, nephews, aunts, uncles, cousins, extended family, and a host of friends.

Mason loved his family, nature, and the outdoors; specifically fishing. He was planning a fishing party for his friends and family prior to his last admission to the hospital. We know that he is in Heaven enjoying his fishing party.

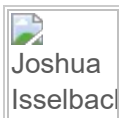

“ *He was a Great Man! I first met Henry at the homeless shelter in Newport News. I would come back from work at night and he would let me in. I remember him laying in the hallway on the phone with his daughter reading Bible scriptures. That's something that always stuck with me. He loved the kids, even if they weren't his. We talked at least 2 times a week, sometimes daily. The last time I saw Henry was when he had the surgery at the V.A. hospital. He was released the next day and called me to thank me for visiting. It was actually my pleasure. We talked about how far we had come from where we first met. He was very proud of me, I now have a family and kids. We would tell each other how Good we have it now from then. I talked to him a couple of times after he got out. I could tell it had taken a toll on him. I had a dream the next day after finding out the news of his passing. In the dream somebody was playing on his phone and the text I received about his viewing and funeral arrangements were not true. We actually had a REAL conversation. My wife woke me up when she got home and I rest up and said "Henry's not dead!" All to realize that it was a dream. I just want to let the family know that he was a dear friend to me. And as I write this, I am shedding some tears. I will miss our conversations. That's my "Bruva" as Henry would say it with the NY accent. Lol. He was "Blessed by Him". Rest easy my friend and Love You Back!*
