Chesapeake - Hilton A. Williams, 66, of the 4000 block of Sun Valley Crescent, entered into eternal peace on Monday, November 16, 2009. Hilton was born on September 12, 1943 in Everetts, NC. He was a dedicated father and husband for 48 years. He was employed with the Nassau County, New York Police Department as an officer and a detective for 24 years.

“ I read in *NEWSDAY* today, June 24, 2022, that a park in Elmont, Long Island was renovated. It was at that park 43 years ago that Police Officer Hilton Williams tried to save my brother Lee Williams' life, but he himself was injured. Lee and two other construction workers lost their lives from methane gas that day, and several first responders, including Officer Williams, were injured attempting to rescue them. In fact, Officer Williams was "pulled out of the hole by his wrists by an EMT who arrived by helicopter".
