On the morning of Monday, February 6, 2017, our beloved husband, father, grandfather, great-grandfather, uncle and loved one Jack E. Kidd Sr. passed away peacefully surrounded by his loved ones. 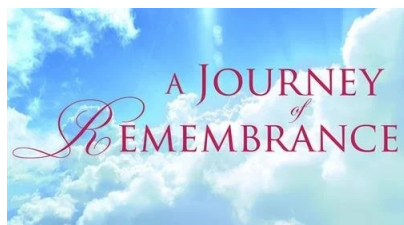

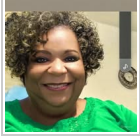
