James Rodgers, Jr. departed his earthly home on Thursday, November 10, 2022. James was the first born of James Rodgers, Sr and Ethel Mae Rodgers in Chesapeake, Virginia on July 13, 1950.

James or 'JR' as known by his closest family and friends, was a graduate of the 1968 class of Crestwood High School in Chesapeake, VA. While attending Norfolk State College, now Norfolk State University, he was drafted into the US Army as a Medical Corpsman. After an honorable discharge, he enlisted in the US Army National Guard, where he retired after 30 years. While serving in the US Army National Guard, James also worked and retired from the Newport News Shipyard as a Master Shipman with 42 years of service.

'JR' was an avid sports enthusiast. He played baseball with Mount Carmel, Lion Tamers, Ptown Greyhounds, and several recreation leagues. 'JR' was also a founding member of the Progressive Athletic Association (PAA) which was known for giving the best dance parties in town! If you knew JR, you know he loved the Pittsburg Steelers, the New York Yankees, and the Norfolk State University Spartans. If you ever came to visit him at home, his "Man Cave" is filled with all things sports related, especially of the Steelers, Yankees, and the Spartans!

'JR' is preceded in death by his parents, James and Ethel May Rodgers, his

brother Lester "Bobie" Rodgers, and a sister Evonne "Peady" R. Mann.
