James Lawrence Rogers, 71 years old of Portsmouth, Virginia entered eternal rest on December 15, 2016. James was born on November 5, 1945 in Margarettsville, North Carolina. He was the son of the late Ovella Rogers and the late Samuel Martin Sr.

He served in the United States Army from 1964 to 1966. He was active duty with the 182nd airborne artillery division Manning 155 Miller Meter Houser. James achieved his high school equivalency during his military service. After his military service James became employed at one of the largest private companies in Portsmouth, VA, Skippy Peanut Butter. He quickly rose to become supervisor, being the first person of color to whole such a position with a company of this size. He was retired from Southern Atlantic Labels in Chesapeake, Virginia.

He enjoyed watching football but his favorite team was the Miami Dolphins. He also enjoyed fishing and spending time with his family. In the last several years you never saw him without his sidekick Arielle. In the true sense of the word he was a “Hero”.
