Jamile Johnay was an esteem member of the Tidewater Community College Honor Society. She was active in civic and political work with the Chesapeake Democratic Committee. She was so proud of her work with the Barak Obama Campaign. Jamile was employed with the YMCA SHR as a child care provider.

Jamile was an award-winning Special Olympics athlete in the areas of basketball, track and field, roller and ice speed skating. Jamile was a ten-year participant in the Polar Plunge.

Jamile loved her Special Olympics and Team Inclusion Family, especially the

Jamile Johnay was a volunteer who supported, tutored and encouraged six male students with disabilities who were ignored by the schools. She was a role model and inspiration for so many!

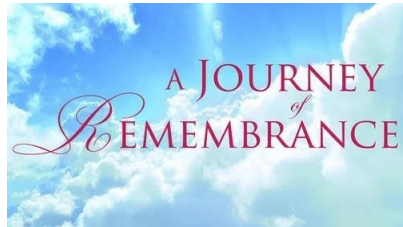

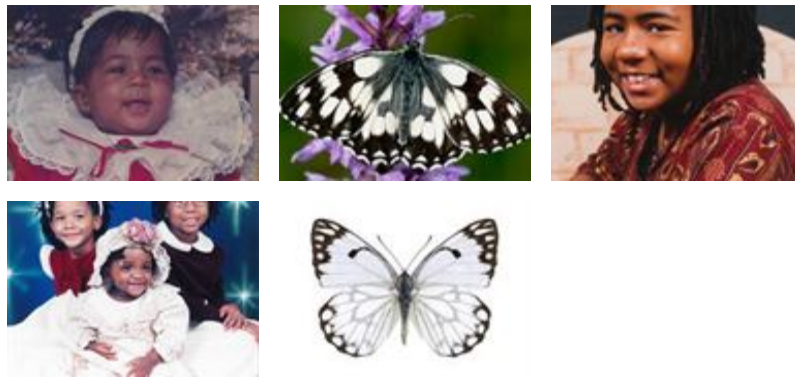

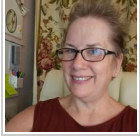
