Jeffery Leonard Stith peacefully joined the Lord on October 6, 2023. Born on August 18, 1967, in Chesapeake, Virginia, to Allie Ray Jr. and Curley Stith Banks. He embraced the Lord as his personal Savior at an early age and was a dedicated member of Third Baptist Church in Portsmouth, Virginia.

Jeffery graduated from Churchland High School in the class of 1985 (known as the 'Truckers'). He held certifications in HVAC and electrical work and dedicated 26 years as a Maintenance Supervisor at Jamestown Commons and Lawson Realty.
