On September 14, 2015 around 7:00 am, Jennie Mae Bratcher Gainey, made her transition from this world to her heavenly home. She was 69 years young. Jennie was born June 25, 1946, in Dunn, North Carolina to the late Geneva McNeil Bratcher and LeRoy Bratcher. She was predeceased by her oldest son Clifford Aaron Gainey Jr., husband Clifford Aaron Gainey Sr., and her great granddaughter Anaya Adams.

Jennie Gainey has been a part of the Portsmouth Public Schools family for many years.
