



Jesse Barnes, Jr.

March 19, 1926 - January 20, 2012

Portsmouth - Jesse “Khaki” Barnes, Jr., 85, of the 100 block of Ivey Street was called home to be with the Lord on Friday, January 20. Jesse was born in Suffolk, VA to the late Jesse and Eula Riddick Barnes on March 19, 1926. He was a graduate of I. C. Norcom High School Class of 1945. Jesse joined the United States Army after graduation where he received significant assignments and medals. He received the 3671st Quartermaster Truck Company in Asiatic Pacific Service Medal and the World War II Victory Medal. Jesse was also involved in the community in which he resided. He was a faithful member of Ebenezer Baptist Church for over 70 years and a member of the No. 2 Choir, the Senior Choir and the Male Chorus. He was also a charter member of the Olympian Sports Club, the Arabia Temple #12, the American Legion Post #190, Brighton Rock Lodge #79, the National Association of Letter Carriers, the I. C. Norcom Class of 43, 44 and 45 and an inductee on December 5, 1987 Athlete Hall of Fame for I. C. Norcom High School.

Jesse was predeceased by his wife, Ernestine J. Barnes. He leaves to cherish his memory children: Mary, Jacqueline, Jessie, Cynthia (Clarence) and Toxie (Ronald); four grandchildren, five great-grandchildren, and dedicated caregivers: Kent Ward, Jr., Jimmie Lee and a dedicated granddaughter, Delmarene M.
