Jesse Lee Council (SNAP) 75 of the 4200 block of Swannanoa Drive, entered into eternal life on October 30 2021. He was born on April 30 1946 in Portsmouth to the late Annie Marie Council-Hunter. Jesse was a graduate of I. C. Norcom High School. He proudly served in the U.S. Army from Dec 1965 until Dec 1967. 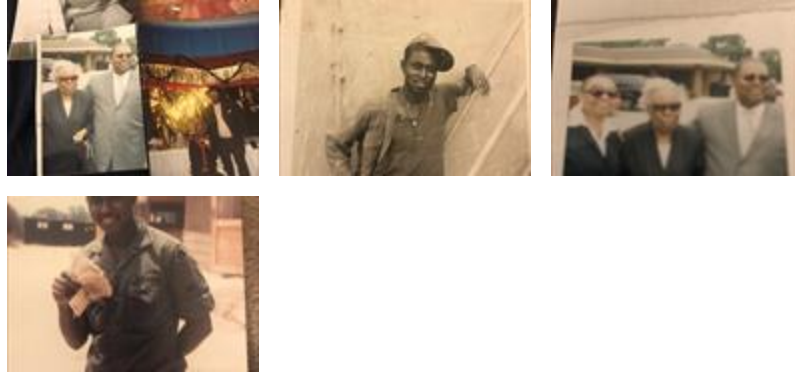

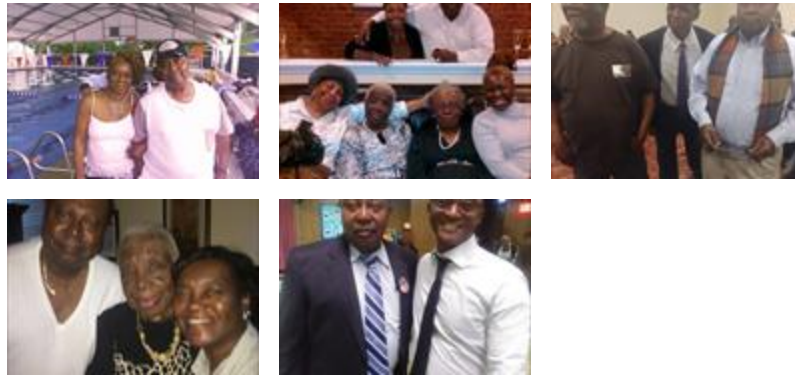
