John Wesley Scott, Jr. passed on July 16, 2024, at Bon Secours Medical Center surrounded by his family.

He was a long-time resident of Portsmouth's Cavalier Manor community. Mr. Scott was born in Elizabeth City County, Virginia, now Hampton City, to John Wesley Scott and Lois Lee Buckner Scott. After graduating from George P. Phenix High School, he received a degree in Electrical Engineering from North Carolina A & T College where he met his wife, Beatrice Reid Scott.

Mr. Scott served as an officer in the U.S. Air Force and after discharge was employed as an Electrical Engineer with the Norfolk Naval Shipyard working on numerous command, control and communication systems where he retired after 32 years of service.
