Kenneth R. Thompson Sr., 62, left us on March 1, 2018, after a tough battle with colon cancer.

Kenneth was born March 13, 1955, in Williamston, North Carolina to the late Mary Magdalene Thompson-Perkins and James Willie Thompson. He attended Christ Temple Holiness Church, which started in his mother's home, under the leadership of Pastor Betsy R. Norman.

He graduated from Ferguson High School in 1973 and joined the United States Army right after. He fought through three deployments and retired as a sergeant after 20 years in the United States Army.
