Kenney Mckeithan , a 24 year old young man from Portsmouth, VA who was diagnosed with stage 4 nasal cancer in 2012. The doctors had no idea how or when the cancer occurred. This young man has been through a number of biopsies, radiation and chemotherapy treatments and severe procedures throughout the early stages of the disease. After eighty rounds of radiation treatment, Kenney has forced to rely on a feeding tube for nourishment. After months of regaining his strength, Kenney was able to finally wing away from the tube and was back on solid foods. In 2014, Kenney was hospitalized numerous times due to infections, pneumonia, and low blood counts. He has been undergone a generous amount of blood transfusions and all while still receiving and dealing with the harsh effects of chemotherapy. In recent months, this gruesome cancer has spread significantly and rapidly in several areas of the body causing confusion, dehydration, lack of desire for nourishment and extreme agitation. The pain and suffering he has endured has been extreme and is only temporary. God has a plan for him and will bring him peace and comfort in his time of need. If you love and we're inspired by Kenney then you can understand how hard this must be. Kenney has always been a loving, supportive, and caring individual. Kenney's strength and courage has enabled him to fight a strong battle against cancer. Despite the doctors reports, Mr. Mckeithan has shown great character in every aspect of his life. 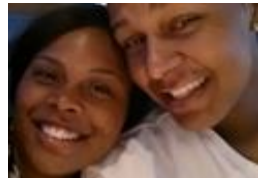
