I first met Tonya in 1995 aboard the USS Eisenhower when I was a young Corporal of Marines. I joined the Marine Detachment mid-deployment while the ship was in port at Naples, Italy. I didn't know anyone and I was 1 of 32 Marine on ship with 5000 Sailors. Had no idea what I was in for. Fortunately for me Tonya was one of the few Sailor that would hangout with the Marines. We all used to eat every meal together ever day. She was so sweet that she would give me most of her food to make sure I had enough to eat. She treated me like a little brother from day one.

Too many memories to share them all, but what are the odds that a small liberty crew mixed with Marines and Sailors in Italy would produce lifelong friends, that had kids during the same timeframe; raising them all almost every weekend at Tonya's house. The grill was always smoking, drinks never ran out; music and Spades tournaments; while the kids played in the yard. I cherish those times and will never forget the Good Ol Days at the Scott's.
