Leon “Bootsy” Wright, 73, of the first block of Suburban Circle departed this life on Sunday, January 13, 2013 at Sentara Obici Hospital, Suffolk. He was retired from the City of New York’s Housing Authority with 20 years of service and from the City of Portsmouth’s Parks and Recreation with 15 years of service. He was known for being the first African American lifeguard at Sunset Lake in the 1950s. Leon was predeceased by his wife, Rosebud Wright, his mother, Mildred W. Pierce and a sister, Rose Chapman. He leaves to cherish his memory two daughters, Tracy Wright Bullock (Robert) and Roslyn Ruffin and two sons, William E. Wright (Noreen) and Leon Wright, Jr. Also left to cherish his memory is a sister, Vivian Jones and a brother, James Wright; eleven grandchildren; twenty-four great grandchildren and a host of other relatives and friends.

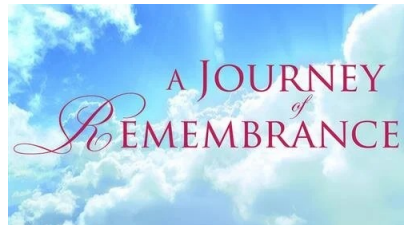
