While serving our country, he was aboard the U.S.S Intrepid (CVS-11) during the Vietnam War.

as a Rigger and later a Loft Mechanic, he became a Training Instructor. Being a training Instructor was one of his greatest achievements being able to teach others and share his knowledge. Leroy was also a part of a Tiger Team that traveled multiple places to include overseas. He was called "Mr. Overtime" by his shop buddies because he worked a lot of overtime to care for his children. Leroy was highly efficient at his job and knew the technical aspects of his job. Because of his astute knowledge and dedication along with his attention to detail, and exceptional performance in all his previous jobs combined; years later, he was promoted to Shop Planner, Rigger Supervisor, and Drydocking Specialist respectfully. He was well respected at the shipyard. He was a "No Nonsense" type of person. He always took his array of jobs seriously along with his dedication to his family.

During his tenure at the Shipyard, he took James M. McCullough Jr. "whom we affectionately call Uncle Mac" under his wings and mentored him along with a superpower lady named Lolita Lee. *He took great care of his work employees, always caring about their wellbeing.

As a member of Brighton Rock AME Zion Church, Leroy was a member of Class #4 and served as a member of the Trustee Ministry from 2010-2022. He also was a member of the Culinary Ministry, a Life Member of the Lay Council and a Honorary Member of the Life Members Council of the Missionary Society. Leroy was a devoted husband, loving father and loyal friend. Family was so important to him always ensuring that his family was well taken care of. He was always concerned about the well-being of others. You'll often hear him say, "You alright?!" When he considered you a friend you had a friend for life. 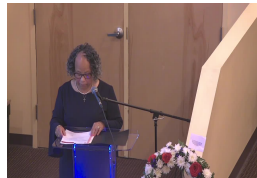

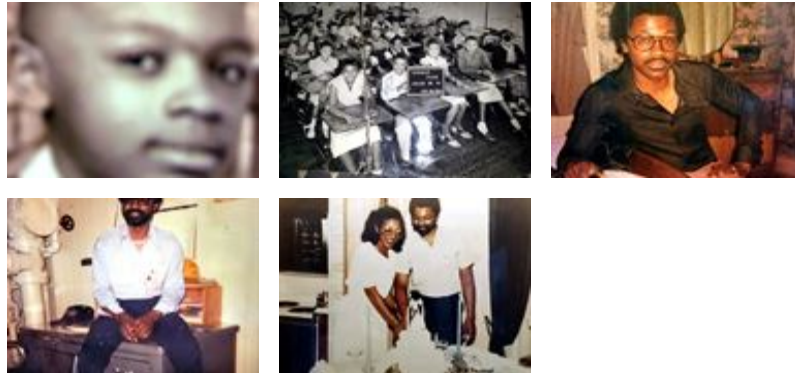
