She later went on to continue studies in Nursing at Tidewater Community College where she received Certification as a Nursing Assistant. Linda began employment at the age of 16 as a food service worker at Golden Skillet. After awhile, she began working in private nursing fulltime, and began her long-term career with Brent-Lox Nursing Home in Chesapeake, VA where she stayed employed for over 28 years before retiring.
