He was born to the late Willie Gray Pulley and Inda Patterson on July 18th 1947 in Littleton, NC however he was raised in Portsmouth, VA. He was a graduate of IC Norcom High School, and was drafted into the US Army shortly thereafter to serve in Vietnam. He earned the rank of Sergeant before his honorable discharge of military service. He was employed by Dominion Energy formerly known as VEPCO for 33 years. He was a first class serviceman working to restore power through hurricanes, ice storms and widespread power outages. Upon retirement he enrolled in the former Keys Business College and earned his certification as a massage therapist.
